Having a strong character is your passport to a successful future.






An opportunity to develop important attributes for life.

- Young people in schools all over England and Wales.


Young people in every kind of school.



What does the Edge involve in our Academy?


- All students in Year 7.

Deliver a presentation to the class on a given topic.


Perform in an assembly with a small group.
