

CVEA Summer Schools 2021 Details and Funding

The CVEA summer schools programme was implemented to help pupils who experienced the most disruption to their education during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. We aimed to provide a range of targeted development opportunities for our students via a blend of appropriate, evidence-based academic and enrichment activities.

At CVEA we determined that the students who would benefit most from a summer school were the Year 6 pupils making the transition into Year 7 in September 2021.

Below you can find brief details of our summer school programme as well as the amount of funding received and a breakdown of the spending.

Summer school funding

What is the Summer schools programme?

The CVEA summer schools programme was set up in response to the impact that the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic had on our youngest students learning. The aim of our summer schools programme was to provide pupils with academic education and enrichment activities in order to mitigate the impact of lost learning, particularly with regard to reading and mathematics.

At Castle View Enterprise Academy, we aimed to ensure that our summer school programme was used by the pupils who would benefit most. In addition to providing support with English, maths and science, the funding was used to improve opportunities for pupils to enhance their learning and wellbeing through a range of activities, including team building, music, art, cooking and sports activities.

The funding enabled the school to:

- Provide quality core subject intervention taught by subject specialist.
- Provide quality enrichment activities that benefitted pupils' social, physical and life skills
- Provide activities that some pupils' parents might not have been able to offer.
- Ensure the pupil to staff ratio was appropriate for the successful delivery of the programme.
- Provide healthy and nutritious meals to pupils attending the summer school.

Difficulties encountered

We encountered no difficulties in providing the summer school with the funding provided. Staff volunteers were able to design, deliver and assess an extremely successful intervention programme to all students. Participation was excellent (two thirds of our Y7 cohort signed up for the summer school) and the benefits to the students and staff in making the transition to secondary school an enjoyable and enriching experience. This would not have been possible without the funding provided and would be part of our regular transition programme if funding could be available yearly.
